Prayer of the Faithful

5. We pray for a renewed sense of mission. May the Holy Spirit guide us into all truth, inspiring us to confront the lack of values in society and to take the lead in building a culture of charity and peace, oriented towards God. (Pause) Lord, hear us.
6. Grant patience, healing and comfort to those who are sick and suffering: Hannah, Henry, Fr William Yip, Mark Halavazis, Sandra Kirner, Henry Chau, Edward Gorzkowski. (Pause) Lord, hear us.
7. Pray for the souls of our recently deceased: Marie Doherty, Florita Dalanon-Montalban, Peter Atkinson, John Mercer, Fred Perera.
